A <i>(eg "11 students a year" rather than "11 students per year")</i>	Per

And above	Or higher + <i>(For example, instead of saying "Windows 7+", say "Windows 7 and above")</i>
Anti-virus	Anti virus Antivirus
Apple Mac <i>(Use "Apple Mac" in the first instance of an article or page. From then on, refer to just "Mac")</i>	Mac MAC <i>(when in an Apple context – obviously referencing a Media Access Control address should still be referred to as such)</i>
Apple macOS <i>(Use "Apple macOS" in the first instance of an article or page. From then on, refer to just "macOS". If referring to a specific version of macOS, write macOS, the version number and version name in brackets afterwards, eg "macOS 10.13 (High Sierra)")</i>	Mac OS Mac OS X <i>(Unless specifically referring to version 10.11 or lower)</i> OSX
Black and white (mono) <i>(Use "Black and white (mono)" in the first instance of an article or page. From then on, refer to just "mono")</i>	Mono Monochrome
Computer	Machine Desktop PC
Click <i>(when using it in the context of a web page which can be viewed on both a desktop and a mobile device)</i>	
eduroam <i>(lower case 'e')</i>	Eduroam
eg, ie and etc	e.g. i.e. etc...
Electronic Software Delivery System	Electronic Software Distribution System
email	Email e-mail

Enquiry <i>(or request, depending on context)</i>	Ticket Job
Ensure	Make sure
Enter <i>(eg, "Enter text into a box")</i>	Type Input Write
ePayments	e-payments
Equipment	Kit
Folder <i>(When not used in a server or Linux context)</i>	Directory <i>(While 'directory' may be accurate, Windows and macOS refer to 'folders' instead)</i>
GlobalProtect	Global Protect
Google Chrome <i>(In the first instance. From then on, refer to just "Chrome")</i>	Chrome
HR Services <i>(When referring to the directorate)</i>	HR
iPhone or iPad	iOS <i>(while iOS is technically correct, users may not know that iOS is the operating systems for iPhones and iPads. iPod touches aren't used enough to warrant a mention!)</i>
Junk email	Spam
Link	Hyperlink
Log in <i>(when used as a verb. For example "Log in to IT Account Manager to change your password")</i>	Login Logon
Log out	Log off
Login <i>(when used as a noun or adjective. For example "Your login information is your University username and password")</i>	Log in Log on
Microsoft Office	Office
Microsoft Windows <i>(Use "Microsoft Windows" in the first instance of an article or page. From then on, refer to just "Windows")</i>	Windows Win
Mozilla Firefox	Firefox FireFox

Setup <i>(when used as a noun or adjective. For example "Go to the setup screen" (adjective) or "This computer's setup is old")</i>	Set up
Shared area / Shared drive	Share <i>(as a noun)</i>

Tap <i>(When used <u>solely</u> in the context of a touchscreen device)</i>	Click
The University of Manchester <i>(Always a capital T, U and M)</i>	Manchester University
Tick	Check <i>(in the context of a checkbox/tickbox)</i>
To	In order to
Transfer	Migrate
University ID card	Staff card Student card <i>(unless referring specifically to staff or students)</i> Library card
University managed computer	Managed Desktop <i>(Unless referring specifically to a desktop computer)</i> Image

University username	Username User name <i>(when in the context of a user's University IT account)</i>
