Getting to us

By Road:

The Jubilee Hotel C Conferences is situated off the M1, JCT 25, 2 miles from Nottingham.

Car Parking:

- Your parking voucher must be printed C displayed as detailed below between 09:15 16:00 weekdays and within the orange parking zones as detailed on the campus map.
- Display your parking voucher face-up in a prominent position on the inside of the windscreen where all details can be clearly read from the outside of the vehicle. Please note, failure to display a paper copy of this parking voucher as detailed will result in a penalty charge notice being issued.
- The parking voucher is valid only for the event on the date/s shown and for the Vehicle Registration, the Event Title and Parking Code detailed on the face. Alternatively, you can purchase a ticket and park in the designated 'Pay and Display' zones as detailed on the campus map.
- The issue of a parking voucher does not guarantee the availability of a parking space and must be used in accordance with any guidance issued by the Security office.
- \cdot This parking voucher is not transferable between vehicles.
- \cdot Any damaged or defaced parking vouchers will be invalid.
- \cdot Vehicles are left entirely at the owner's risk.

By Train:

Nottingham station is easily accessible from most major cities within the UK. The station is 2 miles away with direct transport links.

You can then travel to The Jubilee via bus or Tram (detailed below) or taxi should you wish to do so.

Local taxi company - DG Cars - 0115950500. The best pickup location would be from Station Street.



By Public Transport:

NET Tram - You can travel to the Jubilee Via tram. The tram stop is at the train station. You would need to get on the **Toton Lane** line and get off at Queens Medical Centre where it is then a 15 minute walk to our Campus. A single adult ticket is £3.20 and would need to be purchased prior to boarding and kept for inspection.

Buses:

The Orange line 34 does run from Broadmarsh - opposite café Nero.

You can also get the NCT orange line 35, 36 from Victoria Centre (opposite Waitrose)

Otherwise - it is a short walk to Friar Lane where you can get the: Trent Barton i4 or indigo.

You would need to alight from the bus at Hillside Stop.

The buses do allow both card and cash payments. Though, NCT buses do require the exact change of £2 whilst Trent Barton buses do offer change from small bills.
